Dreaming of an Old World do? Whether you've a taste for hip or historic, here are three romantic spots to consider.



Lausanne

A fairy-tale landscape of castles, lakes and mountains comes together in this French-accented alpine spot.



Galway/Mayo

Ireland's western region and artistic heart offer legendary warmth and gorgeous untamed scenery.



Tuscany

Heady cedar-scented breezes, vineyard-covered hills and cozy trattorias inspire passion.

Ballrooms with weddingcake moldings, elaborate chandeliers and stunning views of Lake Geneva and the Alps grace the grand Beau-Rivage Palace hotel. Rooms from \$434.

Weddings are held throughout Ashford Castle's 300-acre estate, including on the river bluff or great lawn with the circa-1228 castle-turned-hotel as your backdrop, Rooms from \$315.

## COOL VENUE love train

The ST. KITTS SUGAR TRAIN rides along round-the-island tracks orginally laid in 1912 to haul sugar cane. Today the double-decker coaches (bottom level airconditioned, top open-air) can be rented for one-of-a-kind, narrowgauge nuptials. You and your guests board the train and are transported to the location of your choice, where you'll exchange vows. Everyone then re-boards for a roving, rum-punchpowered reception as the train chugs past rainforest, sugar estates and the Caribbean coast. When the festivities end, the conductor unhitches the specially decorated "bedroom car. leaving you and your hubby to cozy up in a locomotive love nest for the night while your guests party their way back to the boarding point.
